PARKS + CONNECTIONS PROP. 407

The PARKS + CONNECTIONS Bond includes \$225 million in General Obligation bonds to fund parks and connectivity improvements throughout the City of Tucson.

The Connections projects include 53 safety and mobility improvements that connect people to parks, local services, transit systems, libraries, and schools.

(Downtown to Reid Park)

- Activate streets socially and economically
- Improve visibility and awareness of people walking

TYPICAL IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE...

PROJECT EXAMPLE IN PROP. 407 36th Street Walkability Project: 2 miles

(6th Street to Country Club)

 Connects to 4 parks, 5 schools, 1 library, and the Bridges Commercial Center

BICYCLE SAFETY & MOBILITY 34 Projects | 100 Miles



PROJECT GOALS

- Creating a network of safer and more comfortable bicycle routes
- Provide on-street bike facilities separated from traffic
- Encourage people of all ages and abilities to ride a bike

TYPICAL IMPROVEMENTS INCLUDE...

- Expansion of Bicycle Boulevard network
- Protected Bike Lanes
- Enhanced crossings
- Shade trees and water harvesting

PROJECT EXAMPLE IN PROP. 407 Blacklidge Bicycle Boulevard: 4.5 miles

(Oracle Road to McCormic Park)

- 4 Enhanced Crossings
- Connects to 5 parks, 4 schools, and Campbell Ave Business District
